

How to FTP to Furnace MFG

The Wonderful World of File Transfer Protocol!



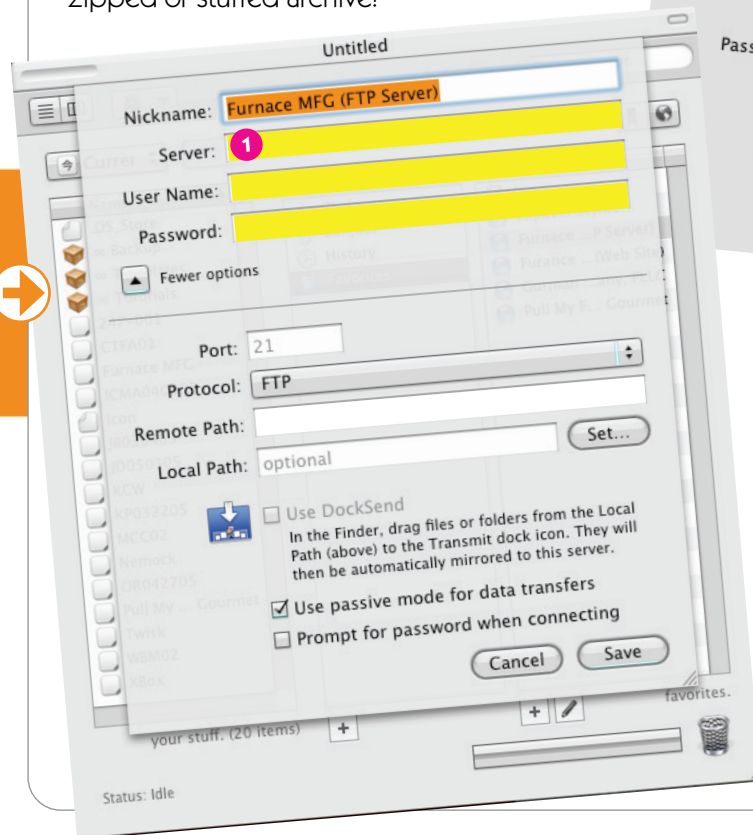
Are you needing to send Furnace MFG a **humongously large file** without putting it onto a disc and sending it to us? Fear not! You can send us your file(s) via FTP (File Transfer Protocol).

First, you must understand that this is not done through a browser. We'll be giving you a URL (along with a username and password). To upload to us, you'll need an **FTP application instead**. Below are a couple FTP applications you can download for the Mac.

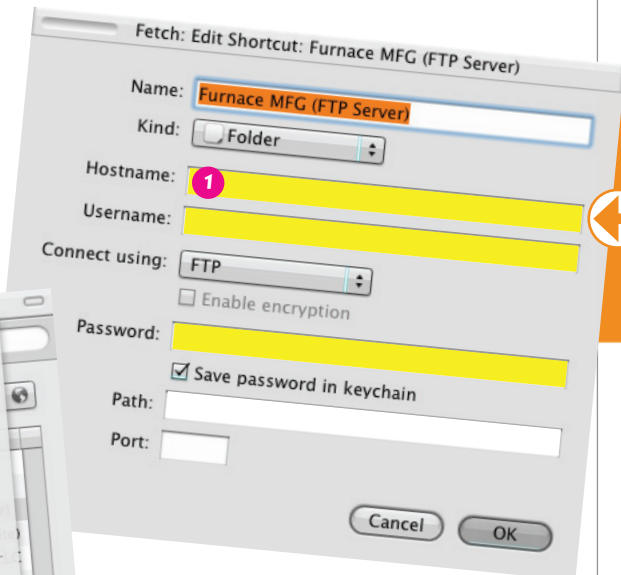
PC users: don't fret! Although we are only showing Mac FTP applications below, the basic concept is still the same on both platforms. Do a Google search for "**free FTP applications**" or go to **www.download.com** and type in FTP application. Once you have an FTP application and open it up, the information below will be the same.

Same Data, Different Terminology

Unfortunately, it seems each FTP application uses **slightly different terminology** (just to make your life harder of course). Luckily, you only need to remember one field in order to connect to our FTP server: the server path. Once you've connected to us, you only need to drag and drop your zipped or stuffed archive!

Any files uploaded without a catalog or job number will be DELETED!
